# Day 1 - August 29, 2022



**Depart: Shelby American Collection -Boulder, CO  
Pit Stop: Mt. Evans Lookout  
Finish: Vail, CO  
Distance: 170mi**

**We kick off our tour of the Rocky Mountains in Boulder, CO at the Shelby American Collection!**

**Registration opens at 9am, and your admission to the museum is included in your entry fee! After touring the museum and attending our drivers meeting you'll hit the road for day one of the RMM!**

**Heading west out of the city you'll follow back roads to Mount Evans and make your first stop at the Mt. Evans Scenic Lookout, the highest paved road in the USA!**

**From there you will wind through the mountains to the picturesque ski town of Vail, CO.**

**Gathering in Vail we will have our first Cars & Cocktails event of the trip. More details TBA**

# Day 2 - August 30, 2022



**Depart: Vail, CO**

**Pit Stop: Leadville, CO**

**Finish: Ouray, CO**

**Distance: 260mi**

**We continue with Day 2 of the RMM event. After a peaceful coffee at the foot of Vail Mtn. we will hit the open road for the historic mining town of Ouray, CO.**

**Headed southwest from Vail we will pass Breckenridge, through Leadville, CO, and eventually meet up with the "Million Dollar Highway" on our way into Ouray, Co.**





# Day 3 - August 31, 2022



**Depart: Ouray, CO**

**Pit Stop: Chimney Rock**

**Finish: South Fork, CO**

**Distance: 175mi**

**After a fun evening of exploring the local watering holes of the authentic mining town of Ouray, we will set off in the morning for South Fork, CO.**

**Our drive will take us along the Million Dollar Highway to Durango, past Chimney Rock, and stopping for the day in South Fork.**



# Day 4 - September 1, 2022

**Depart: South Fork, CO**

**Finish: Crested Butte, CO**

**Distance: 170mi**

**From South Fork we catch highway 149, a fantastic winding and scenic highway on our way to Crested Butte, CO.**

**Our route today takes us on a beautiful drive through Rio Grand National Forest, Lake City, and through countless picturesque mountain peaks and passes.**





# Day 5 - September 2, 2022

**Depart: Crested Butte, CO**

**Finish: Golden, CO**

**Distance: 155mi**

**For our 5th and final day of driving we make our way from Crested Butte northeast toward Golden CO.**

**Following scenic US 285, we will wind our way back up towards our final destination of Golden, CO. Why Golden? That will be revealed soon. We have an exciting finish planned for all of our participants!**





# Hotel Partners


**Hotel Partners are being finalized as of 3/29/22. With some changes in the route due to new sponsors and activity availability we have had to move some hotels around.**
