Day 1 - October 10, 2022

Depart: Newport, RI

Finish: Provincetown, MA

Distance: 126 miles - 4 hours driving time

Kicking off from historic Newport, we set off on backroads towards the tip of Cape Cod, Provincetown, MA!

Along the route there will be no shortage of shoreline vistas, shops, restaurants, and quaint towns.

Day 2 - October 11, 2022



Depart: Provincetown, MA

Pit Stop: Boston, MA

Finish: Gloucester, MA

Distance: 157 miles - 5 hours driving time

Setting off from Provincetown we will begin making our way north towards Gloucester.

Travelling through Boston we continue north to Gloucester, MA a sleepy coastal town on the shores of the Atlantic Ocean.

Enjoy dinner at "Mile Marker One" a fantastic waterfront restaurant where you can experience true New England Clam Chowder and other local cuisine.





Day 3 - October 12, 2022

Depart: Gloucester, MA

Pit Stop:

Finish: Meredith, NH

Distance: 103 miles, - 3 hours driving time



Setting off from Gloucester, we head inland in hunt of that stunning New England fall foliage.

There will be no shortage of winding roads and opportunities for leaf peeping as we make our way to the shores of Lake Winnepesaukee to Meredith , NH



Day 4 - October 13, 2022

Depart: Meredith, NH

Finish: Portland, ME

Distance: 116 miles - 3.5 hours

On Day 4 we head back towards the coast, saying goodbye to New Hampshire as we enter Maine.

Portland is situated on a peninsula that extends into Casco Bay, by mid-october the trees should be a range of vibrant and amazing colors.

Portland is also a great town to seek out your lobster dinner for the trip!





Day 5 - October 14, 2022

Depart: Portland, ME

Finish: Bar Harbor, ME

Distance: 160 miles - 4 hours driving time

Our final day we continue north to Bar Harbor, ME.

Sitting on the edge of Acadia National Park and surrounded by the Cranberry Islands Bar Harbor is an unforgettable fall destination

We will cap of the evening with festivities at a local establishment, stay tuned for more details!





Hotel Partners


