#### Day 1 - May 15, 2023



**Depart: Evanston, IL** 

**Activity: Wisconsin Auto Museum** 

Finish: Sheboygan, WI

Mileage: 170mi

We will kick off our tour of Lake Michigan in downtown Evanston at the Double Clutch Brewing Company! Come hungry because they have a FANTASTIC breakfast menu.

Heading north on Sheridan Road we will experience some of the best roads on Chicago's North Shore.

Our activity for the day is a stop at the Wisconsin Auto Museum, entry is included in your registration fee.

From there we head north to Sheboygan, WI, plans for the evening are TBA.

### Day 2 - May 16, 2023



Depart: Sheboygan, WI

Pit Stop: Sturgeon Bay, WI

Finish: Escanaba, MI

Mileage: 230mi

Day two we head out from Sheboygan and head to Sturgeon Bay for a glimpse of Door County. Feel free to head into the peninsula as far as you wish, we will be stopping for the night in Escanaba, MI

There are no structured events for this evening to allow folks to travel at their own pace, so grab some of your new friends and head out on the town for the evening!





#### Day 3 - May 17, 2023



Depart: Escanaba, MI

**Activity: Mackinac Bridge Crossing** 

Finish: Charlevoix, MI

Mileage: 217mi

From Escanaba we head across the top of Lake Michigan and the UP. There are a few options for state parks and Points of interest you can choose visit today:

- -Pictured Rocks National Lakeshore
- -Soo Locks Visitors Center
- -Fayette Historic State Park

After enjoying your day in the UP, head across the Mighty Mackianc Bridge, follow the route through the tunnel of trees and into downtown Charlevoix

# Day 4 - May 18, 2023



Depart: Charlevoix, MI Activity: Drag Strip Day

Finish: Ludington, MI

Mileage: 200mi

Departing Charlevoix we wrap up around Grand Traverse Bay, then over to Leland for Lunch, then south along the shore till we turn inland to head towards the Northern Michigan Dragaway! Today everyone will get a chance to set a few ¼ mile times.

After testing out our lead feet and our vehicle's performance we finish the day with a short and easy drive to Ludington, MI





## Day 5 - May 19, 2023



**Depart: Ludington, MI** 

**Suggested Stop: Grand Haven or Holland** 

Finish: St. Joe/Benton Harbor, MI

Mileage: 160mi

Our final day together we will travel down the western shore of the "Mitten State." We have a leisurely drive through many fantastic harbor towns. Stop for lunch in Grand Haven, or Holland, and enjoy a waterfront view while you dine.

We finish the day and our trip in Benton Harbor, with evening activities TBA soon!
